What's In the Package

T9



Power Button

Press and hold

Ouick press

(Power ON/OFF) Golf Mode (end the mode)

Watch Mode

* The tiny hole at the top of the watch is not a reset button. How to reset : Press and hold power button for 10 seconds to restart T9. restart the watch.

Charging Dock



How to Charge

- Connect provided charging dock to USB port.
- Connect T9 on the charging dock by aligning watch face with T9 text inside charging dock.
- * If T9 is not correctly connected to charging dock, charging may not work properly.

Strap (20mm)

Both a long strap and a short strap provided

Screen Description

Shot & Putt Tracking



Shot Tracking

Recognizes and displays automatic/manual shots during a round

Putt Tracking

Recognizes and displays automatic/manual putts during a round



e.g., After tee shot

Driver distance will show once at ball location and before 2nd shot is taken.

e.g., 7 shots and 5 putts



Red dashes show shot count. Blue dashes show putt count.

Screen Description

How to change watch face



- Press and hold on the watch face to enter the watch face setting screen
- Change watch face by sliding to left and right
- Touch the dot at the top of the screen to change color
- When setting is complete, touch the \checkmark at the bottom of the screen

Time / Date Settings

Automatic setting_outdoor only



When Golf Mode is selected Time is automatically set after GPS signal is received

Manual setting_indoor/outdoor possible

- On the Menu screen, touch S > Time



Touch Current Time in the list to enter, then swipe up and down to set the time

- On the Menu screen, touch @ > Time



Touch Date in the list to enter, then swipe up and down to set the date

General Settings

Set User Info

- On the Menu screen, touch @ > User info.



Swipe up and down to set correct user info. Select \checkmark when done editing.

Change Language

- On the Menu screen, touch () > Language



Swipe up and down to set language desired.

Notification Settings

- On the Menu screen, touch (2) > Notification



Select (Vibration) or Preview to editing settings.

Golf Options

Change Unit of Measurement

- On the Menu screen, touch (2) > Golf option > Unit Change



Swipe up and down to set correct unit of measurement

Scoring settings

- On the Menu screen, touch (2) > Golf option > Scoring



Simple Mode Automatically tracks score throughout round

Advanced Mode Prompt to manually set strokes and putts will appear after each hole.

Slope Compensation Settings

- On the Menu screen, touch (2) > Golf option > Dist. Measurement.



Adj. Slope Dist. Distance provided will include slope adjustments

Tournament Distance provided will not include slope adjustments

Golf Options (Cont.)

Driver Distance Setting

- On the Menu screen, touch (2) > Golf option > Driver Dist.



Swipe up or down to set your normal driver distance.

Select ~ when done editing.

Driver Arc will appear on course preview when available.

Night Mode

- On the Menu screen, touch (2) > Golf option > Night Mode



Night mode will keep back light on during entire round until you exit golf mode



What is V.AI™?

An Al-based golf service that automatically provides necessary information by detecting the golfer's location and situation so that the golfer can focus on his or her swing during a round.

e.g.,

 teeing area, entering fairway after tee shot, entering green attack area, on green



Course map auto zoom

Auto-switch to Green View

Shot Feedback View : detects a shot and displays distance and tempo
 Shot & Putt Tracking : automatically detects and displays shots & putts

* How to deactivate V AI Menu > Settings > Golf Setting > V AI > OFF



 Shot Tempo : Automatically provides the swing tempo of the shot immediately after shot is taken



Automatically provides backswing, downswing, and tempo by detecting the golfer's swing

Golf ball distance : When the icon is touched, the distance
 and tempo of the previous shot are shown.



Touch the **SHOT** icon or the distance number icon to see distance and shot tempo

* When the \bigcirc icon is touched, the distance is measured manually and the number of shot is added.

Enter Golf Mode

Golf Mode

When the Golf Mode icon is touched, T9 will search for current course GPS and automatically detect starting hole.



Switch to the 'Course View /Green View/Yardage View' screen

To enter Green View/Putt View/Yardage View

Swipe the 'Course View' screen when running Golf Mode for the first time.



- Course View, Green View, Putt View images may vary with regions and golf course situations.
- *'Yardage View' displays key data in large numbers when the + button icon is tapped



Course Preview at the teeing area

- If you touch the 'Course Preview' icon (S),
 - the device will play 'Course Preview'.
- It shows the distance to a bunker close to where

the tee shot lands

Once the playback is finished, the screen returns to Golf Mode * If the screen is touched during playback, it immediately returns to Golf Mode



HDCP/IP/Driver Distance It shows information on bunkers and hazards It shows distance to the pin



When the relevant bunker or hazard is touched, the distance to the front and back of the bunker/hazard is displayed.



* Touch on the enlarged screen is easier.



Real Green Undulation

It indicates in 11 stages, using the actual measured green undulation data

Green Zoom (2-stage)

When the **(**) icon is touched, the green is expanded ('Pin Reload' is supported)



Real Green Undulation

Green Zoom (2-stage)

- Touch the icon once (Stage 1) / twice (Stage 2)



The shape of the green automatically rotates as the golfer's location changes





It shows the height and distance from the ball to the pin



When standing next to ball location, tap ball icon () to show remaining distance and slope to pin.

- Move to where the ball lies and touches the ball icon (
- ② Return to where the pin lies and touch the pin icon (●), and height and distance are provided.
- Zoom in or out with the +/- tap. You can toggle between screens by dragging on the expanded screen

Tempo Practice Mode

What is tempo practice mode?

A mode that provides practice in timing the tempo by setting a target tempo, so that you can practice for a consistent swing.

 On the menu screen, touch 1 > Choose from [Full Swing/Approach/Putt]



Tempo Practice Mode

2 ways to set target tempo

 Amidst the Tempo Mode items, touch [Target Tempo] > Choose from among [Full Swing/Approach/Putt]



· Touch and hold the center of the screen in Tempo Mode



* When setting the Target Tempo, the target speed is displayed as a color circle. Fast (Red), Accurate (Blue), Slow (Yellow)
